

## Sep 28/2020 - WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT LEAGUE PLAY

These are highlights only. Please read the full COVID-19 protocol on the website.

- **No schedules** will be posted at the Club. Check the schedule on the website for your game time and the sheet you are playing on.
- **Arrive** no sooner than 15 minutes before game time. Some leagues will have the door locked when the game begins, so don't be late.
- **Masks** are required at all times except when seated. Masks on-ice are optional.
- **Bring** your own equipment (shoes, broom, stabilizer); tissues; water bottle (clearly marked)
- **Follow** these steps when you arrive:
  - Come dressed to play (no lockers are available)
  - Leave outdoor footwear on the racks.
  - Go to the table designated for your ice.
  - Leave your coat and curling bag at the chair.
  - Change your shoes there and proceed to the ice.
  - After the game, return to the same chair.
- **On ice:**
  - Proceed to the designated position on the ice.
  - Leads decide hammer. Sanitize the wheel.
  - Leads will use the wipes to sanitize rocks for their team.
  - Vice-Skip throwing blue rocks records the score for both teams.
  - One sweeper only. Sweep between hog line and top of the rings.
  - Skips may sweep in the house if they choose. Keep physical distance.
  - Each team designates one player to clear their rocks, using their broom to touch the rocks.
  - Winning team sends the score to the convenor electronically.

## **Spares:**

- If you need a spare, contact all bye team members first
- If a spare comes from a different league, they must sign in (to allow contact tracing if necessary)
  
- **Other stuff:**
  - Day leagues will use the time clock (2 hour games) to allow cleaning before the next league
  - Coffee & tea & bar service will be done by one person to minimize contact. No food will be served.
  - Curlers are asked to keep track of when they play in order to assist public health officers if contact tracing is required.
  - All of these restrictions are meant to keep you safe. We will loosen them if and when the COVID situation improves.
  - Please be patient with your League Convenor. We are all learning together.
