

Provincial Curling Action

The Brighton and Trenton curling clubs are co-hosting a provincial curling bonspiel starting Friday January 12th through Sunday the 14th.

The Fairfield Marriott Challenge brings together some of the best Ontario mens' teams in this one exciting event. There will be 32 teams representing curling clubs from across the province. Some of the towns and cities represented are Ottawa, Burlington, Lindsay, Whitby, East York, Mississauga, London, Peterborough, and Kitchener-Waterloo. In a previous level of competition, the Jeremy Gale team from Campbellford have won the right to represent our local area in this event.

All teams compete in a double-knock-out format. We will see a total of 61 games which will result in 4 divisional/event champions. This competition is sanctioned by the Ontario Curling Association, and is sponsored by one of the country's leading hotel chains. The Brighton and Trenton curling clubs have established an excellent track record in hosting this annual competition, and have now hosted it more than 25 consecutive years.

The schedule will have the first two sets of games on Friday the 12th, starting at 6:30 pm. Saturday's schedule will start at 9:30 am, with four sets of games. The last Saturday game starts at 6 pm. On Sunday, the semi-final games will be played at 9:30 am. The championship games for all four divisions will be played in Brighton, at 2pm.
